

**MINUTES OF PARTINGTON PARISH COUNCIL MEETING
HELD ON MONDAY 8th OCTOBER 2018 AT 6.30 PM
AT THE COMMUNITY CENTRE, PARTINGTON**

The unveiling will be on 27th October. A community garden is also in the pipeline but is still in its early stages; watch this space.
